"Bet I do," she said.

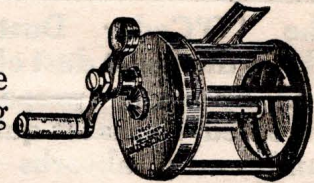
On being pressed for particulars as to how it was done, she replied: "You take the cow into the barn and give her some breakfast food and water and then you drain her crankcase."

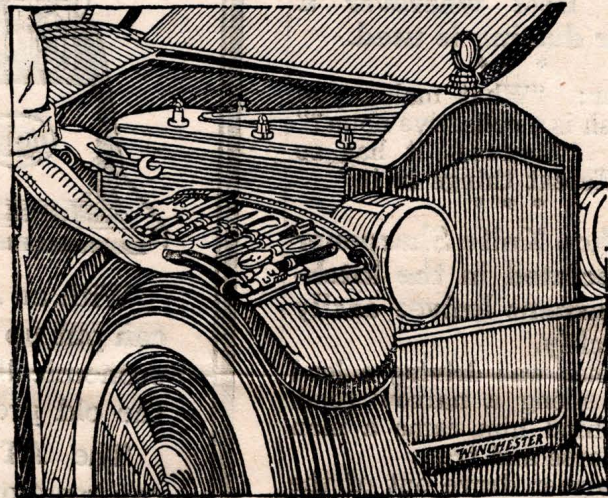
