Ivan B. Wescott Dies at Dalton

Ivan B. Wescott, 107 Wescott St., Dalton, died Tuesday afternoon at his home after an illness.

Born in Nicholson, son of the late Lowell and Harriet Chase Wescott, he resided for some time in Fleetville where he operated a general store. He moved to Dalton 43 years ago where he owned and operated the Wescott Hardware Store until his retirement in 1944.

He and his wife, the former Frances S. Smith, celebrated their 51st wedding anniversary June 12 of last year.

Mr. Wescott was a member of Dalton United Methodist Church, Trustee Emeritus, and had served as Sunday School Superintendent for 20 years there. He was a member of the Dalton Volunteer Fire Co., former chief, president and treasurer for many years.

An Army veteran of World War I, he was a member of the American Legion, Post 213, Dalton, and was a member of the advisory board of the Dalton branch of the First National Bank of Carbondale. He was also a charter member of the Dalton Lions Club and had served as its treasurer for many years. He was a member of Factoryville Lodge 341, F&AM, and also was a member of Tall Cedars of Lebanon, NESPA Forest.

In addition to his widow, he is survived by a son, Neal L. New Milford, and three grandchildren.
